Significant Singapore Economic Driver

- In 2010, the electronics manufacturing output grew by 26.9%, compared to global industry's growth of 9.3%
- Within this, the Singapore semiconductor industry grew 49.8%, outpacing the global industry's growth of 32.5%
- Semiconductor sector makes up 62% (S\$ 55.7 billion) of the Electronics manufacturing output
- Employing approximately 38,000 people
- Increasing Singapore's share in worldwide semiconductor revenue to 13.5%, compared to 6.3% in 2001.
- Singapore is the second biggest city in the world in terms of wafer capacity

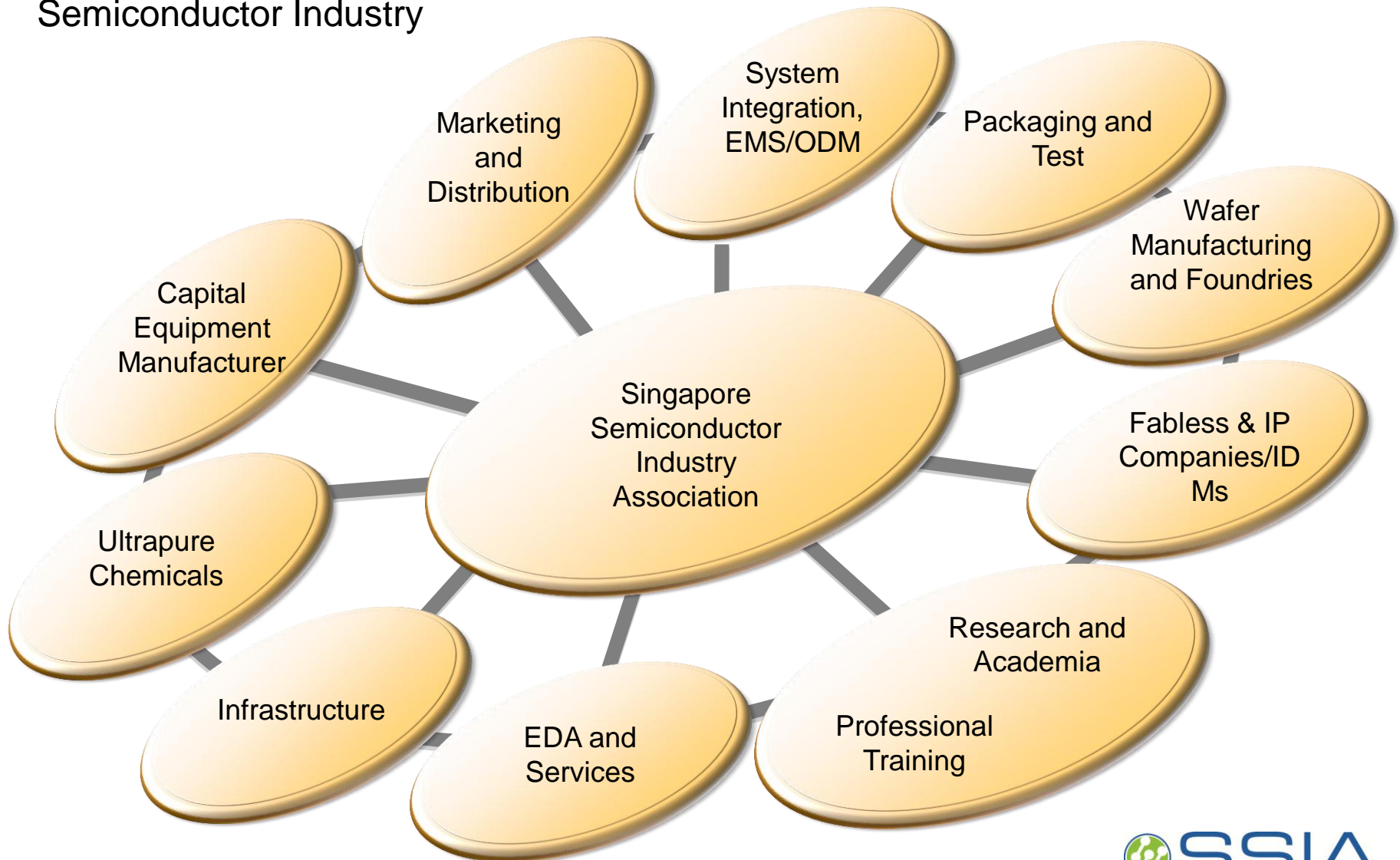

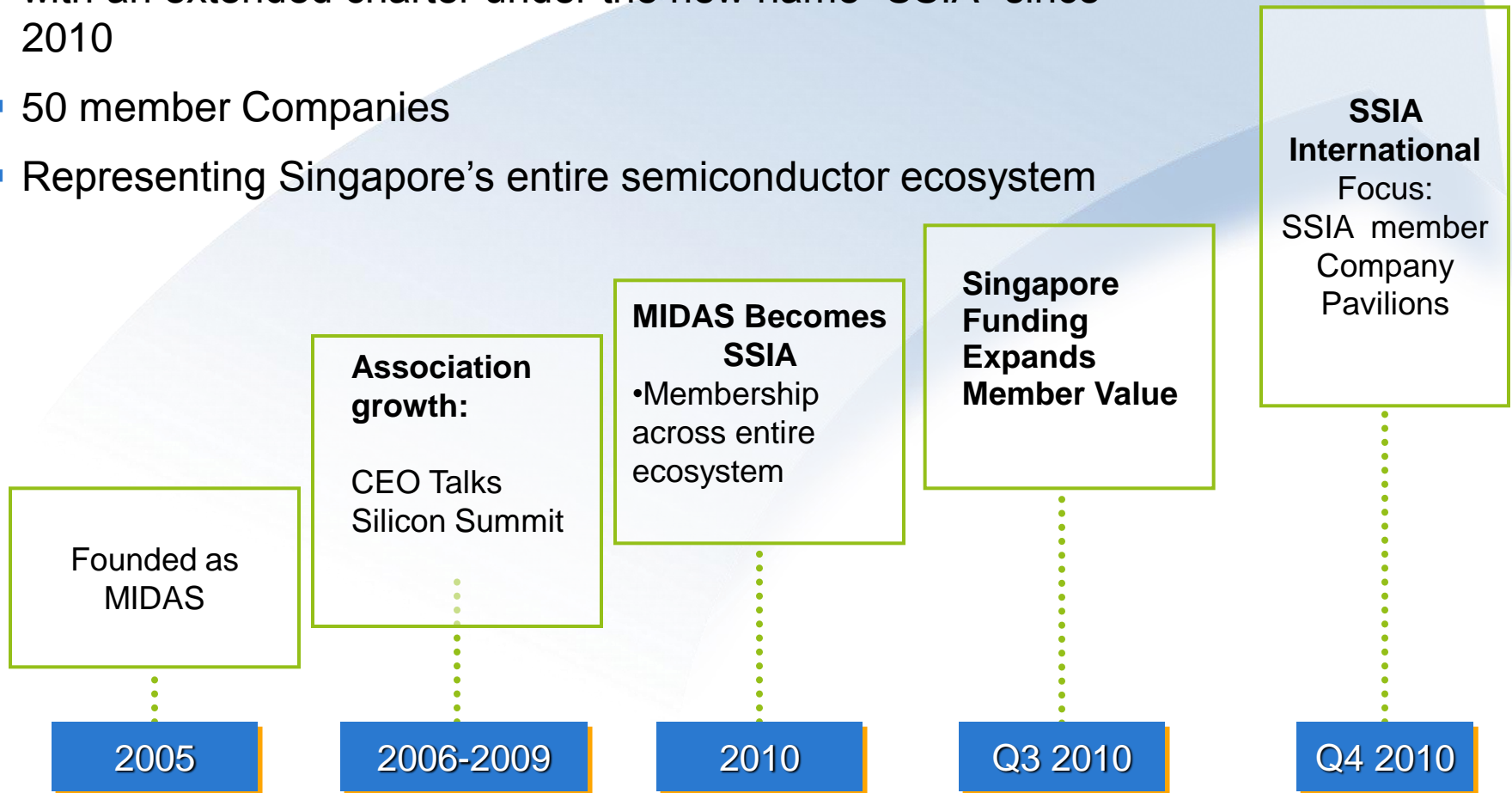

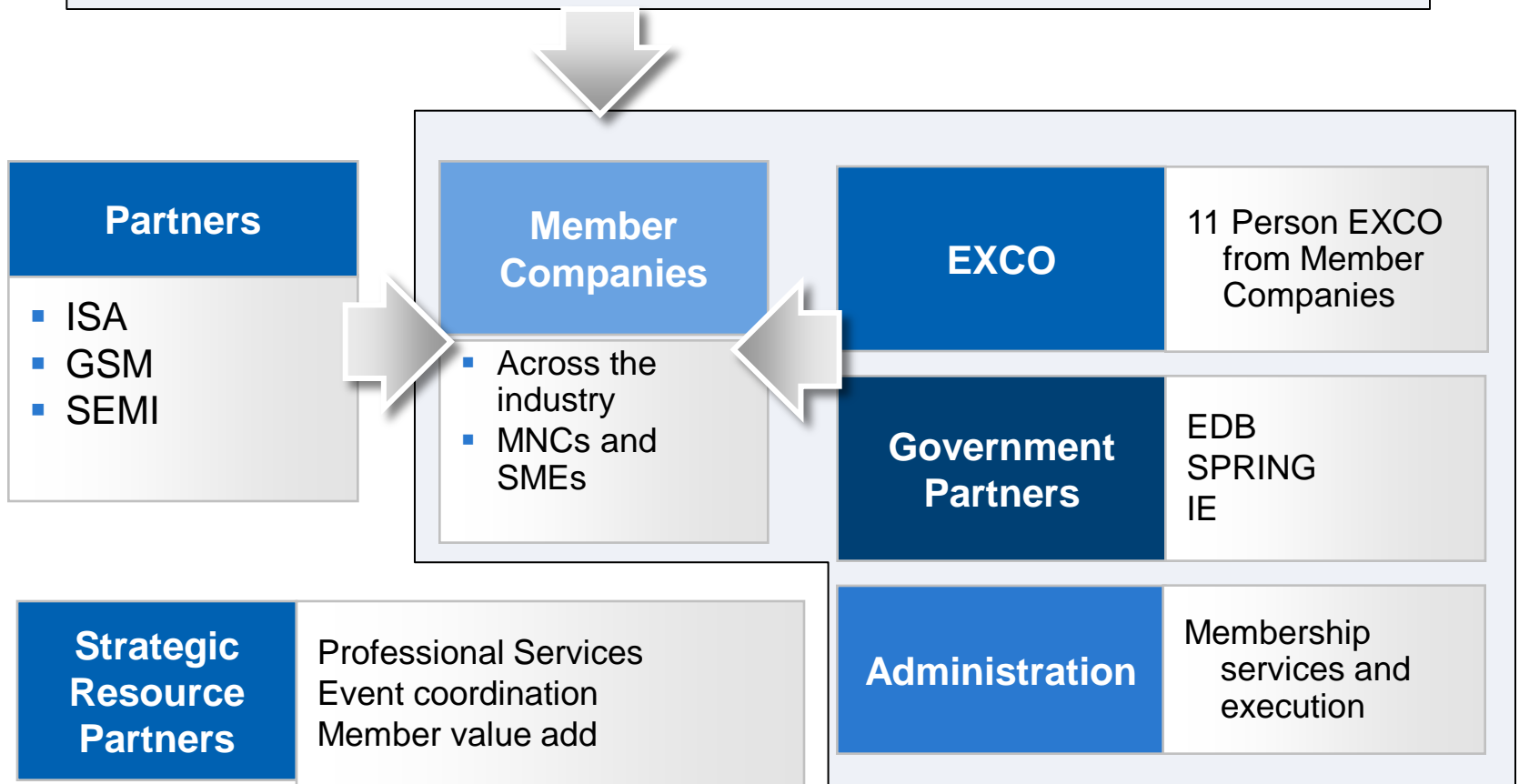
